


START JOURNEY IN THE SPIRITUAL FIELD AT JUST 14 YEARS OLD



RAPE IN INDIA: A NATION'S NEGLIGENCE AND THE DIRE STATE OF WOMEN'S SAFETY

n India, the word "rape" has become synonymous with an uncomfortable truth that the nation struggles to face. Despite the numerous incidents of sexual violence

that dominate headlines, there is a disturbing pattern of negligence that permeates every level of society—from law enforcement to the judiciary, and even within communities themselves. This negligence has created an environment where women are not safe, and where justice is often an elusive dream for survivors.

A CULTURE OF SILENCE AND INACTION -

Rape cases in India are often met with silence and indifference. Whether it's the reluctance to report the crime due to fear of stigma, or the lack of urgency from authorities to investigate and prosecute, the resp<mark>onse is</mark> consistently inadequate. This culture of silence only emboldens perpetrators, who know that the odds of facing consequences are slim. For many survivors, the journey toward justice is fraught with obstacles. Police stations, which should be safe havens, often become battlegrounds where victims are met with skepticism and victim-blaming. The legal process is slow and bureaucratic, with cases dragging on for years, leaving survivors to relive their trauma with little hope for closure.

THE FAILURE OF INSTITUTIONS -

India's institutional response to rape is deeply flawed. Despite laws meant to protect

women, the implementation is weak. In many cases, police fail to register complaints, or worse, they pressure survivors to settle or withdraw their cases. Courts, too, are bogged down by delays, and the conviction rate for rape cases remains abysmally low.

This negligence is compounded by societal attitudes that trivialize rape and place the burden of shame on the victim rather than the perpetrator. These attitudes are pervasive, cutting across all strata of society, and they contribute to a toxic environment where women are afraid to speak out and seek justice.

The notion that India is unsafe for women is not just a perception—it's a reality. From urban centers to rural areas, women face the threat of sexual violence daily. Q. What's the most significant lesson you've learned as a female entrepreneur?


